

NUNC PRO TUNC REFERRAL OF BANKRUPTCY MATTERS
TO BANKRUPTCY JUDGES

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157, the District Court hereby
ORDERS nunc pro tunc that any and all cases under Title 11
and any and all proceedings arising under Title 11 or arising
in or related to a case under Title 11 be and hereby are referred
to the Bankruptcy Judges for the Southern District of Mississippi
for consideration and resolution consistent with the law.

This order, which is effective from and after June 27, 1984,
applies to all pending bankruptcy cases, except those on appeal
to the District Court, and all bankruptcy cases and proceedings
hereinafter filed in the Southern District of Mississippi.
