

Important Notice Regarding Payment of Filing Fees

Effective October 4, 2010, **failure to pay filing fees** in accordance with the requirements of Fed. R. Bankr. P. Rule 1006 and Section 3 (A)(7) the court's *Administrative Procedures for Electronic Case Filing* (www.mssb.uscourts.gov) will result in **revocation of access to the Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) system as a registered filer.**

Fed. R. Bankr. P. Rule 1006:

- (a) Every petition shall be accompanied by the filing fee except...
- (b) ...if accompanied by the debtor's signed application... stating that the debtor is unable to pay the filing fee except in installments.
- (c) A voluntary chapter 7 petition... if accompanied by the debtor's application requesting a waiver under 28 U.S.C. § 1930(f)...

Miss. Local Bankr. Rule 5005-1

All documents submitted in all cases and proceedings shall be filed electronically, and signed or verified by electronic means, in compliance with the Administrative Procedures for Electronic Case Filing established and maintained by the respective courts.

Section 3 (A)(7) *Administrative Procedures Electronic Case Filing*

All payment of fees for CM/ECF transactions must be made the same day the transaction is submitted.
