**ORDER ALLOWING TEMPORARY EXCEPTION FROM  
MANDATORY ELECTRONIC FILING ON EMERGENCY  
BASIS AND EXTENDING DEADLINES IF AUTHORIZED**

Because of technical failures, registered users of the Case Management/Electronic Case Files ("CM/ECF") system in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Mississippi will be unable to access CM/ECF via the internet during the next twelve (12) or twenty-four (24) hours. The Court, therefore, finds that a temporary exception from mandatory electronic filing for all registered users should be allowed on an emergency basis pursuant to MISS. BANKR. L.R. 5005-1. In addition, the Court finds that registered users of the CM/ECF system should be allowed to file pleadings and documents due on December 1, 2015 on paper. Finally, the Court finds that all deadlines for filing documents and pleadings due on December 1, 2015, should be extended for one (1) day, unless further extended, but only if such extensions otherwise are authorized by the Bankruptcy Code and/or the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that an exception to mandatory electronic filing for all registered users of the CM/ECF system shall be allowed for one (1) day, unless further extended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all registered users of the CM/ECF system shall be allowed to file pleadings and documents due on December 1, 2015 on paper.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all deadlines for filing documents and pleadings due

December 1, 2015, shall be extended for one (1) day, but only if such extensions otherwise are authorized by the Bankruptcy Code and/or the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

SO ORDERED. Effective December 1, 2015.




