

**Revised Federal Bankruptcy Forms  
Effective April 1, 2016**

Effective April 1, 2016, certain automatic/statutory adjustments to dollar amounts stated in various provisions Title 11 and Title 28 of the United States Code will become effective.

Seven Official Bankruptcy Forms and three Director's Forms will change

The revised forms will required for cases filed on or after April 1, 2016.
