

New Electronic Filing Requirements for Notices with Objection or Response Deadlines

Effective July 18, 2016, new and modified docket events will be available for filing a notice that provides for a specific deadline date or a response/objection period (No. of days).

If a notice provides for a response/objection period, the filer must enter the date the notice was served. The ECF system calculates the deadline date based on the date of service. However, the docketed deadline date will also warn that an additional three days may be added to the response period depending on the particular circumstances of service. ***See Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006.***
