

The Court entered a Standing Order Regarding Motion to Extend or Impose the Automatic Stay (the "Standing Order") effective September 20, 2011. The Standing Order set forth certain procedural requirements for a motion to extend or impose the automatic stay. The Court subsequently entered an Order Adopting Amended Uniform Local Bankruptcy Rules effective June 1, 2018. The procedures set forth in the Standing Order have now been superseded by Miss. Bankr. L. R. 4001-1, as amended June 1, 2018, by the Order Adopting Amended Uniform Local Bankruptcy Rules. Accordingly, the Bankruptcy Judges of the Southern District of Mississippi do hereby repeal and rescind the Standing Order effective June 1, 2018.
